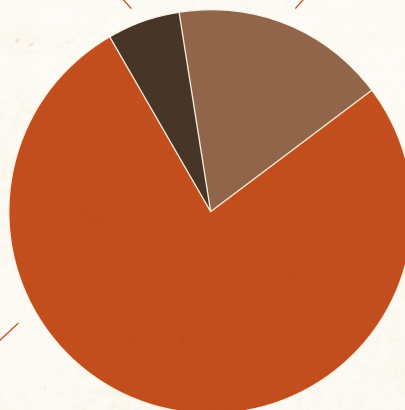

# Letter From The President

Bringing It All Back Home! Who said you can't go home again? Helping Paws is doing just that to celebrate 35 remarkable years and hundreds of incredible volunteer foster home trainers and caretaker homes. In 1985 when this journey began as a pilot project of the University of Minnesota's Center for the Study of Human-Animal Relationships and Environment, no one could foresee the impact that Helping Paws would make on our community. We built a home that became the starting place of love, hope and dreams.

Those dreams were led for decades by Helping Paws founder Eileen Bohn. Eileen was involved in every aspect of Helping Paws and was particularly skilled at pairing dogs with their partners. The lives of hundreds of individuals with physical disabilities, veterans and first responders with PTSD, and the mental health industry have all benefited from Eileen's dedication and ability to recognize the needs of the community. Eileen announced her well-deserved retirement

in May this year and although she is missed, her dedication and contributions will be forever remembered. Helping Paws is committed to continue to grow and thrive.

And grow we have! Under the direction of Executive Director Alyssa Golob, who joined us in early 2022, Helping Paws is taking steps to broaden our reach and fulfill the goal of breeding, raising, training, and placing more dogs each year. Those efforts include expanding our staff and giving current staff members new opportunities to grow. The hard work and dedication of this new dream team of individuals is already paying off. Helping Paws placed 16 assistance dogs last year!

The appropriately named star of 2023 is Nova, the Stearns County Attorney's Office facility dog placed with handler Keli Trautman. In July, Nova accompanied a teenage sexual assault victim on the witness stand for five hours, providing reassurance and reducing anxiety, which enabled the young victim to give critical testimony. This was a first in Minnesota! Nova's accomplishment has been celebrated locally and nationally, including a story on Give To America!

We are beyond grateful for our hardworking staff, tireless volunteers, generous donors, and faithful supporters. Each of you is a gift and we can never say this enough: Thank You.



# Letter From The Executive Director

An organization that has reached 35 years is not only something to be proud of, it is something to be admired.

The foundation of Helping Paws began on the solid ground of the University of Minnesota Center to Study Human-Animal Relationships and Environments (CENSHARE) in 1985, and just three years later, it became its own 501c3, under the leadership of Eileen Bohn. Helping Paws placed its first service dog, Alpha, that year, and a dream became a reality. Since Alpha, over 300 dogs have been placed, and 1000's of lives have been changed.

Due to the pandemic, it took over 3 years for this connection to happen. She has diverted my focus away from my troubles and problems, infusing my life with abundant joy.

Our new life together has seen a road trip to Duluth, watching my son’s opera concert in Eau Claire, countless walks (every day), and easier visits to the hospital! I never thought in my wildest dreams, that I would be brushing my dog’s teeth every night, laughing and singing to her. What a gift.

Helping Paws assistance dog Wabe and I have been a team for a year now. In that time, she has helped me in multiple ways.

I can engage more positively with the public, as Wabe consistently elicits smiles and compliments from people. This creates opportunities for me to interact with strangers more easily.

I sometimes have bad dreams or nightmares and Wabe is there to wake me up and reassure me. She senses when I am stressed or ramped up and will remind me to re-center myself. She's been a calming presence for our entire family.

Having Wabe in my life, as well as my family's life, has been wonderful. I am so grateful and thankful for Helping Paws and the outstanding volunteers who help care for and train these assistance dogs.

When I stand my brain doesn't process where I am in space and in relation to objects so I constantly walk into things or fall. With Humphrey at my side he is a constant presence in an ever changing environment. Humphrey next to me gives me a guide of where I am. I know and trust he knows where the door frame is and can safely get me through it. He knows where a wall is and can help me turn a corner. He knows where the sidewalk ends and there is a drop to the curb and I follow his body movement.

I do have structural issues that make it hard to pick things up, he assists me in retrieving items. With Humphrey at my side, I am able to go out independently and not have to worry I will be injured. There is such a feeling of pride to be able to say I did it. Humphrey allows me to take walks outside. I had a goal this year to walk a 5K. We did it in June!! I came in dead last but Humphrey and I did it.

Humphrey is a serious professional when working. However, when we're at home and relaxing, he loves to do zoomies and rolling in the grass is a favorite of his. He "helps" the environment by collecting every stick he can find, and he loves to swim in the lake. Foster Trainers can never be given enough thanks for the gift they give us and I will forever be grateful to Jordy and Beth for Humphrey. And enough can't be said for the support we receive from Sue and Jenny to help make us a successful team. I will always be grateful to Helping Paws.
