OUR NEW LOCATION IN EDEN PRARIE

Helping Paws has relocated to a larger facility in Eden Prairie, expanding by 3,000 square feet in preparation for our breeding program expansion. Construction and remodeling began in January 2024 and was completed in March 2024. After a successful move and unpacking in April 2024, classes resumed at our new facility.

On May 5, 2024, we hosted a grand opening that saw hundreds of our community members celebrating the life-changing assistance dogs we provide. Eden Prairie Mayor, Ron Case, even declared it Helping Paws Day in Eden Prairie!



MORE DOGS, MORE IMPACT!

At Helping Paws, we witness the profound impact service dogs have on individuals and communities daily. Our More Dogs, More Impact – The Helping Paws Breeding Program Expansion program aims to expand our Breeding Program from 6 to 15 dogs, addressing the urgent need of our three-year waitlist. This expansion will quadruple the number of individuals receiving life-changing service dogs each year. To kick off our public campaign, the KAHR Foundation generously provided a \$100,000 challenge match.
